# Burgundy 2009 En Primeur Offer

## Introduction

The 2009 vintage will perhaps be remembered as a terrific one for the Rhône, an exceptional one for Bordeaux ...and for Burgundy...maybe one that will challenge the 2005 that some people call the 'vintage of the century' a term rarely used by Burgundians. Either way, it will be one talked about for years to come.

Following a cold winter which gave way to an orderly spring, flowering was not hindered by any inclement weather. July was interspersed with rain and hot days and growers started to become a little uneasy. August and September brought bright sunny days and cool nights, ideal for developing phenolic ripeness and retaining fruit characters during fermentation. Two weeks before harvest, there were huge downpours resulting in swollen grapes. The weather then returned to normal and became quite hot, but not too hot - not like the baked 2003 vintage – and a northerly wind helped bring the berries to their optimum ripeness.

## The Wines

The wines are full of richness and weight across both reds and whites. What is very apparent is the theme of consistency, a kind of homogeneous nature, whilst this may have the odd traditionalists thinking, 'this is a little un-burgundian', most will love the overall quality. There is no question that the 2009 vintage is definitely a good one, will it be superior to the 2005? We will have to wait and see.

Ample sun throughout the Côte d'Or helped to produce Pinot Noirs that are pure and show excellent minerality and depth. They may not be as powerful as the '05s but they are rich in fruit, both on the nose and palate, suggesting the potential longevity of the wines, "it is a bit like the 2005 vintage but better. Many people will be interested in '09 because they are a very fruit driven style, with the body and depth of 2005 but without the 'in your face' tannins." one grower mentioned. The wealth of ripeness, depth and structure makes this an excellent cellaring vintage.

The whites continue on a run of excellent vintages, the words that kept coming through in our tasting notes for them were 'citrus', 'vanilla' and 'minerality'. This is a vintage for those who love rich

and fresh wines for the long term.


## Recommendation

Wines from Gevrey and Nuits Saint Georges did very well. Sylvie Esmonin's wines were intensely perfumed with huge flavour profiles and Mortet continued with his impressive silky and classy style. As in 2008, wines from Nuits Saint Georges had lots of depth and charm, both Chevillon and Gouges were in full motion - wines with big flavour profiles. In Vosne Romanée, Yves Confuron produced well extracted and powerful wines – it's no wonder they age so well. Rising Volnay superstar, Nicolas Rossignol, clearly captured his various terroirs, an exciting producer to watch. In the whites, the Meursaults from Jean Philippe Fichet expressed more mineral-infused tones with less oak and loads of fruit. The minerality of Hurbert Lamy's in Saint Aubin exceed most, while in Chassagne, the intriguing comparison between brothers Thomas and Vincent Morey is worth discovering. Francois Carillon's wines had a certain 'nervosité' but with layers of fruit and natural finesse, some of the best from Puligny.

New producers to the Genesis portfolio include Albert Bichot and Pierre André. These are two of the new breed of dynamic negociants and are worthy of more than just a glance in passing. With a stable of Grand Crus and Premier Crus, Bichot has a long history of winemaking in the Côte d'Or. In Corton, Pierre André's wines, both white and red exuded class and character that we can highly recommend.

In some cases, growers have maintained their prices, others have increased. With the Pound slightly stronger against the Euro some of these increases have been offset. What is more intriguing is the growing interest from Asia, the combination of a laissez-faire attitude towards price and culturally embedded need to impress means that they will pay almost anything, potentially great news for those looking to invest.

We feel that the 2009 vintage has produced a style that can be enjoyed early, yet has all the ingredients to age beautifully. For those that missed out on the 2005 vintage, here is a chance to acquire what could be the next best or potentially better vintage.

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# Mâconnais

## Domaine Christophe Cordier, Pouilly Fuissé

We have been working with Christophe for several years now and as each one goes by he continues to confirm that he is one of the standout producers of the Mâconnais. His wines have a style and balance of more illustrious villages further north but with trade mark added concentration. It is worth noting that Christophe employs less oak with each passing vintage.

### White

#### Saint Véran Clos à la Côte

130.00

Very pure nose with rich orchard fruits and oak aromas. The palate shows good weight and complexity, the oak notes are more upfront and provide good depth. The fruit is more to the back but is very present. There is complexity and verve on the palate and some mouthcoating flavour that will allow the wine to age well. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 17.

#### Pouilly Fuissé

130.00

Wonderful yellow in colour; the nose shows apricot and peach fruits - super rich and very composed. On the palate it has good concentration, a little vanilla and fabulous herbaceous acidity. Some white stone fruit flavours together with a little honey and good citrus fruits gives an overall linear impression. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17+.

#### Pouilly Fuissé Les Vignes Blanches

210.00

Still on lees when sampled. Very pure nose with a touch of honey - pear and apricot fruits too. On the palate it shows touches of melon and light tropical fruits. Very pure and fresh, there is a lively acidity that carries right through on the finish. This is very rich and very round with smooth mouthfeel and excellent complexity. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 18.

#### Pouilly Fuissé Vers Cras

210.00

Delicious caramel notes and a little butter with some brioche on the nose. The palate is complex, traces of honey with some sweet vanilla are at the fore, the oak provides a slight creamy backdrop with a good drop of minerality poured on it. The finish is very long and pure, polished and exciting in the mouth. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+.

### Red

#### Morgon Côte du Puy Vieilles Vignes

94.00

Lovely cassis nose, very expressive with currant and black cherry fruits. The palate shows loads of black fruits, this is so intense yet so pure and elegant at the same time. Quite a delicious Beaujolais! Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 17.

# Côte de Beaune

## Domaine Jean Philippe Fichet, Meursault

Situated in the relative foothills of Meursault Jean-Philippe has now reinforced his reputation as one of the top producers in this illustrious village. Classy wines with concentration and precision we are extremely proud to have them in our portfolio, with even the straight Bourgogne cuvées having a cult following of their own.

### White

#### Hautes Côtes de Beaune - Very limited 105.00

A very zesty and attractive nose with a ripe lime and grapefruit lift - very little oak here. The palate reveals much more orchard fruits with excellent definition in the mouth. A little citrus fruit with refreshing acidity adds to a charming finish. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 16+.

#### Bourgogne Blanc - Very limited 115.00

Light mineral tones with hints of ripe lime fruit on the nose - very pure and clean. The palate is very soft and elegant in style. Not overwhelming with fruit flavours, there are more delicate notes of peach, pear and nectarine. This is not your run of the mill Bourgogne Blanc. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 16.5.

#### Bourgogne Blanc Vieilles Vignes - Very limited 144.00

Gorgeous nose - very fresh and pure with plenty of white stone fruits and light citrus tones. There is a wonderful richness on the palate that coats the mouth creating a classy feel. With terrific acidity, a little spice comes through helping to create a lingering finish. There is nice drive and symmetry in this wine. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 16.5+.

#### Meursault - Very limited 250.00

Pretty aromas of white flowers and sweet orchard fruits - lovely almost tropical tones here too. With good fruit expression on the palate there is a little tartness that keeps it in check. This has incredible mouthfeel and is delicious on the finish with sweet white fruits, a touch of oak and lasting acidity. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 17.

#### Meursault Meix Sous Le Château - Very limited 285.00

A juicy and satisfying nose - an immediate burst of lemony freshness followed by aromas of white flowers and stone fruits. On the palate, this intense fruit impact comes forward generously coating the mouth. There is some initial heat cooled with layers of light citrus fruits. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17+.

#### Meursault Vieilles Vignes Les Gruyaches - Very limited 325.00

Light mineral aromas complemented by hints of white fleshed peach, hazelnut and gardenia. The palate shows hazelnut and kernel-like flavours together with citrus notes that lean more towards orange than lemon. There are flavours of pear, honey and a little nectarine that round the citrus tones off. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17.5.

#### Meursault Chevalières - Very limited 360.00

Wonderfully perfumed nose that exudes generous aromas of cream, peaches, pear and some roasted nuts. The palate is more silky and sleek with a lovely mineral/saline-like quality. A nice creamy element to match the mandarin and lemon flavours gives the wine plenty of finesse. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+.

#### Meursault Les Tessons - Very limited 375.00

The nose is quite exotic - a blend of ripe lime with acacia flower followed by light honey undertones and some white stone fruits. The palate has a delicious mineral texture with plenty of elegance, it envelopes everything with its purity and richness. The finish is long and persistent with a little toast and warmth to complement. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+.

#### Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Les Referts - SOLD OUT 500.00

Rich notes of green apple and stone fruits - nectarine and white peach, and some toasted almond too. The palate is very rich and concentrated, fleshy white fruits complement the fine oak tones providing body and depth. Fresh with vibrant citrus flavours, this is top Puligny with serious poise. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+.

**Red****Bourgogne Rouge - Very limited** 108.00

Very red fruit nose with strawberry and raspberry scents to the front. Not going for big extraction here, the palate is well balanced showing excellent ripeness with layers of integrated oak. There is a pleasing crunch on the finish that will help the wine to age. A well made Bourgogne, lively and fresh. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 15.5.

**Monthelie 1er Cru Les Clous - Very limited** 195.00

A very appealing and lively nose with red cherry and raspberry fruits followed with a touch of mint. Concentrated red fruits pour onto the palate. The oak is beautifully integrated with fine grained tannins coating the mouth. An elegant wine. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 16+.

**Domaine Hubert & Olivier Lamy, Saint Aubin**

Saint Aubin is arguably one of the insiders' secrets of the Côte d'Or and the Lamys epitomise this: their vineyard sites may not be the most prestigious in Burgundy but they know what to do with those that they have, crafting wines which punch far above their weight at great value prices. The whites have a delightful ripeness to them but serious vinosity on the palate too, while the reds have an unforced lightness showing a marked femininity and freshness.

**White****Saint Aubin La Princée** 185.00

Wonderful minerality on the nose with plenty of fruit - crisp granny smith apple with notes of white flowers. The palate is fuller showing excellent ripeness and a warming mouthfeel wrapped with lovely acidity - very Chassagne-like but with more Puligny minerality. It has a lengthy finish with a touch of citrus. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 16+.

**Saint Aubin 1er Cru Clos de Meix** 234.00

A very clean, true and pure nose with some chalky complexity - much more minerality than fruit. The oak notes together with the minerality help create a vibrant and round palate. This is complimented with some finely tuned acidity that gives good balance and length on the finish. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17.

**Saint Aubin 1er Cru En Remilly - Limited** 300.00

Glorious nose of blossom, peach and pear fruits but with some citrus notes too. The palate is very expressive and linear with an intense minerality that provides vibrancy and lift. Fatter in style than the Meix the peach skin and white fruit flavours appear with oak tone lifting on the finish. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17+.

**Puligny Montrachet Les Tremblots** 300.00

Whilst there are light notes of ripe white peach and nectarine fruits, an added mineral aspect signals the wine's quality. The palate has ripe lemon tones and an attractive pithy liveliness. It is very pure and fresh with some mouthwatering acidity that cuts through. This is a good Puligny. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 16.5+.

**Red****Chassagne Montrachet Vieilles Vignes La Goujonne** 180.00

Soft notes of ripe raspberry, cherry and strawberry on the nose - the fruit notes are upfront with the oak in the background. It is wonderfully pleasant on the palate coating the mouth with red fruit and integrated oak. It has a round and supple feel with a lasting finish and a little dry lift. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 16.

**Saint Aubin 1er Cru Derrière chez Edward Vieilles Vignes** 235.00

Lovely perfume on the nose with accents of cherry - some chalkiness and complexity too. Rich and elegant red fruits lie underneath a layer of upfront but smooth tannins. The oak is beautifully built-in and helps give the wine elegance and finesse. With a touch of spice and a warming texture the finish is lengthy. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 16+.

## Domaine Louis Carillon, Puligny Montrachet

As one of the superstar properties of the Côte de Beaune, Carillon doesn't really need much introduction. Suffice it to say they perennially make some of the best Puligny around. Father Louis had long since handed the winemaking reigns to the next generation, Jacques and Francois. Recently, the domaine has been split between the two. We continue to source wines from Francois and the allocations are still highly sort after.

### White

**Chassagne Montrachet** 250.00

A lovely citrus burst on the nose complemented by delightful mineral notes and hazelnut overtones. In the mouth it is very rounded and shows good concentration and weight that is kept in check by a mid-palate burst of vibrant lemon. Complex and very promising. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 16.5+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.

**Puligny Montrachet - Limited** 250.00

Very mineral on the nose with hints of ripe stone fruits and a touch of vanilla pod - there is so much freshness. The palate is full-bodied, round and warming. The acidity is lively with wonderful zesty flavours that linger on the finish. Very Puligny with good length too. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 17. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Les Combettes - SOLD OUT** 410.00

Wonderfully fragrant white stone fruits on the nose with more subdued aromas of honey and beeswax. The palate is streamlined with mouth-coating minerality, there is also a pleasing amount of tension here, a linear-like style that is invigorating. Brilliant acidity heightened by mouth-watering citrus fruit flavours persists on the finish. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 18+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Les Perrières - Limited** 420.00

The nose is much lighter in fruit than the Combettes - with a bit more oak evident and some herbaceous notes present. The palate however, is much richer than expected. With plenty of depth, an attractive creamy edge is towards the front of the palate. Ripe peach and nectarine fruit flavours round off and a balanced kick of acidity lingers on the finish. Delicious wine. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 18.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Les Referts - SOLD OUT** 430.00

An attractive nose with very well balanced oak against a wall of lovely apple and blossom aromas. A mineral impact in the mouth is more prevalent than the fruit. Very grand cru like with a wealth of minerality, there is lots of linear precision and immense length on the finish. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 18.5+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.5.

## Domaine Vincent Morey, Chassagne Montrachet

Vincent has taken over the domaine but Bernard, his father, is still helping and advising. With vineyards in both the Santenay and Chassagne appellations he makes whites and reds that are racy yet refined and are great ambassadors for these villages. Vincent's brother Thomas has his own domaine. (see page 7)

### White

**Santenay 1er Cru Passetemps** 220.00

A striking nose of apple, blossom and white flowers. Less intense on the palate, there is a nice snap of acidity that complements a weighty and rich feel. The finish is long and fresh - a distinctive and very likeable wine. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 16.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.

**Chassagne Montrachet Vieilles Vignes** 250.00

Soft notes of white fleshed fruits - pear and nectarine on the nose. Full-bodied in style the minerality coats the mouth right through to the back of the palate, there is plenty of fleshiness as it unfurls with time in the glass. Hints of nuts and cream and sheer concentration leave a long and persistent finish. Drink from 2017. Genesis Score 17. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.5.

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Baudines** 310.00

Attractive aromas of soft peach and apricot with gentle notes of hazelnut. On the palate there is a burst of lemon that gives way to some distinct minerality. Still quite light and youthful, the lovely mineral notes together with the brilliant acidity provide a very big, long, and succulent finish. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.5.

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot** 340.00

A very pure and mineral nose with light tropical notes and a touch of earthiness. The mouthfeel is very attractive with a silky glossiness, yet quite light and youthful. The palate has hints of apple and pear lined with a little oak and minerality. The finish is promising with good length. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Embrazées** 340.00

Such a generous nose of red apple, pear, almond and hazelnut - a little spice too. There is so much freshness and depth here, the mineral aspect is very upfront with the fruit following behind. Big and round in the mouth, there is good acidity that complements the slight creamy notes and noticeable oak. The finish grows and grows to be very lasting. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Caillerets – Very limited** 445.00

Fabulous nose - lifted nectarine and peach tones with an underlying minerality. The palate shows no flabbiness and has excellent linear minerality. Nectarine and pear flavours a more at the fore here. The mouthfeel is so generous, rich and yet supple at the same time. Will be interesting to see this fatten out with time. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 18.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.5.

**Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru La Truffière – Very limited** 470.00

Surprisingly more rich on the nose than the Chassagnes. Hints of white peach and lemon with a little nuttiness too. The palate is very Puligny with its fine acidity and mouthwatering minerality. Notes of oak linger providing some depth and structure. It has a big finish that goes on and on, very pure and very clean. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 18.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.5.

**Red****Santenay 1er Cru Passetemps – Limited** 180.00

Rich dark fruits on the nose with pretty hints of violets and some cassis as well. The oak is beautifully integrated on the palate. The mouthfeel is gentle yet so concentrated. The tannins are more to the back of the palate with the fruit remaining upfront. With good intensity and depth it has a lovely long finish sprinkled with seasoned oak. A well-made and polished wine. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.5.

**Thomas Morey, Chassagne Montrachet**

Thomas is the latest edition to the established Morey dynasty (the younger son of Bernard). Whereas you might expect the new kid on the block to make very 21st century opulent wines, his style actually seems to be far more angular and adroit, and have become a success with true lovers of white Burgundy. Sadly very small quantities are available.

**White****Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Baudines – Very limited** 330.00

A very classical Chassagne nose with notes of white fleshed fruits and a prevailing minerality that oozes freshness. The palate is ripe and attractive with an elegant mouthfeel. The oak comes through on the finish which is very pure. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot – Very limited** 345.00

An initial burst of lemon gives way to a distinct minerality. Herbaceous notes are more evident than fruit. The minerality creates a coating mouthfeel, so pure and elegant. This is a seriously complex wine with terrific acidity and a thirst quenching finish that goes on and on. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 17.5. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.5.

**Red****Santenay Vieilles Vignes – Limited** 144.00

Very polished ripe black cherry and blackberry fruits create a glamorous nose. The palate expresses savoury tones that are complemented by notes of oak and rich berry fruit flavours. There is plenty of structure and depth to this wine providing roundness and a finish that lingers. Simply delicious. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 16+. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 17.

## Domaine De Courcel, Pommard

De Courcel is a family owned Pommard based domaine with a twist; they have appointed a winemaker, Yves Confuron, from another property (see Confuron-Cotetidot). Yves has introduced longer elevage and concentration-inducing vineyard management techniques that result in wines for the more patient among us. Once these structured yet silky wines open up though, they show incredible fruit quality and balance that will guarantee to impress.

### Red

**Pommard Vaumuriens** 370.00

A tightly bound nose with a sprinkle of oak on top of some fresh currant and raspberry fruits. The fruit is driven towards the front of the palate, the back reveals finer grained oak immersed in some dark cherry flavours. Very classy in style, the tannins are generous with a good drop of acidity. This wine will age beautifully. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 17.

**Pommard 1er Cru Les Croix Noires** 415.00

More dense than the Vaumuriens this has deep aromas of red fruits and a little cassis - a shot of minerality too with light earthy tones. The palate has a soft fur-like texture with fine grained tannins and mineral notes coating the mouth. This is a big structured wine that will age very well. Drink from 2017. Genesis Score 17.5

**Pommard 1er Cru Grand Clos des Epenots** 495.00

The nose is almost impenetrable with its rich earth and mineral strength, there are jammy fruit aromas of currant and raspberry too. The palate is rich and well extracted providing good colour and depth. With layers of fine tannins coating the mouth there is a certain elegance that is also bridled with power. A fabulous, well-rounded and powerful wine. Drink from 2019. Genesis Score 18.

**Pommard 1er Cru Les Rugiens – Very limited** 600.00

The nose is deep and somewhat exotic - forest floor with overtones of liquorice. The palate is much sweeter and fruit-filled with lots of cassis. There is plenty of depth and concentration that gives this wine structure and poise. The fruit carries right through on the finish which is long and delicious. Drink from 2019. Genesis Score 18.5.

## Pierre André, Aloxe Corton

Château de Corton André looks out across the Corton hill and is the home of Pierre André. The Corton hill vineyards produce truly rare and marvellous Burgundies which are at the very peak of the region's finest wines. They produce both Grand Cru red (Corton) and Grand Cru white (Corton Charlemagne) wines. These exceptional Grand Cru parcels of land are the very essence of Pierre André.

### White

**Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Blanchots** 470.00

Very perfumed and sexy nose with pear, almond and mineral scents - a voluptuous style with notes of cream and butterscotch too. The oak provides depth and structure carrying the lovely ripe white fruits. A medium acidity pulls it all together creating elegance, not cloying but pure and fresh. A superb Chassagne Montrachet. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 17.5.

**Meursault 1er Cru Les Genévrières** 525.00

A very mineral nose with hints of flint and overtones of pear, lemon and seasoned oak. The palate is round and attractive showing good use of oak and white stone fruits with a little spice. There is good concentration and mouthfeel which, with the oak and some bright acidity, follows through to give a long and warming finish. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5+.

**Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru** 875.00

Very dense tropical aromas with undertones of orchard fruits - pear and peach. The orchard fruits are more evident on the palate, together with some classy oak and a subtle creaminess, the wine is rich and full bodied in style. There is less acidity than the Blanchots but enough to carry the depth of the wine through on the finish. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 18.5.

### Red

**Savigny les Beaune 1er Cru Clos des Guettes** 195.00

Very high tones of ripe raspberry and cherry fruits with a hint of spice. These red fruits are quite rich on the palate. Made in a medium-bodied style, licorice flavours with a sprinkle of spice and oak lean towards the back palate. Towards the finish there is a little rounded crunch, but overall a great wine. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 16.5.

<b>Corton Chaumes Grand Cru</b>	575.00

#### Nuits Saint Georges 1er Cru Les Saint Georges - SOLD OUT

An incredibly dense and almost impenetrable nose of rich red fruits, spice and a touch of mocha. The palate has intense depth with rich fruit notes, some youthful wood and minerality showing. There is plenty of freshness and tannin that give structure, and loads of flavour, that will allow this wine to age beautifully. Drink from 2019. Genesis Score 18.5.

## Domaine Denis Mortet, Gevrey Chambertin

It appears that for the second year Arnaud has taken the domaine's wines in a more feminine direction with again there being less extraction and oak dominant flavours. Instead sweet and delicate fruit profiles come to the fore. Beautiful and remarkably approachable wines.

#### Bourgogne Blanc

Lovely grapefruit notes fill the nose with mineral overtones. The fresh fruit flavours come through on the palate providing a bright impact. Ripe and pure there are tropical notes, pineapple with a hint of mango. Well-structured the finish is firm with some good weight. Drink from 2012. Genesis Score 16.5.

#### Bourgogne Rouge

Great Pinot Noir nose, very attractive with its supple red berry tones. The red berry fruits really show on the palate, together with some finely integrated oak, light acidity and supple tannins, The wine is a pleasure to drink and has a soft fruity finish. Drink from 2013. Genesis Score 16.5.

#### Gevrey Chambertin

A light and subtle nose makes way for a little spice and some good creamy red fruit flavours. This is wonderfully fresh and supple. There is structure and fruit that are in balance. Very ripe but not cloying because there is good acidity and fine tannins. Drink from 2015. Genesis Score 17+.

#### Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes

More chiseled and incisive on the palate than the straight Gevrey Chambertin. The austerity of its structure is balanced with wonderful fruit tones and a fine mineral aspect. The oak is integrated and balanced with the soft tannins and sweet red fruits. The wine has a very pretty and long finish. Drink from 2016. Genesis Score 17.5.

**Gevrey Chambertin En Champs – Limited** 520.00

Very concentrated nose with strong notes of black cherry and cassis, a touch of almond and some wet stone like minerality. The wine structure is imposing but softened with these ripe black fruits and shows a lot of class from the start. The finish is long and lasting, conveying fresh red fruits and a fine streak of minerality. Drink from 2014. Genesis Score 17.5.

**Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru - SOLD OUT** 720.00

Very straightforward on the nose, cassis and dark fruit move onto an exciting and likeable palate that shows lots of creaminess. There is some lively acidity that gives a bit of crunch, this is balanced by some lovely ripe red fruits. Fine tannins round off with a silky finish. Very good. Drink from 2017. Genesis Score 18.

**Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Champeaux – Very limited** 720.00

Almost grand cru like, the minerality jumps out on the nose, the fruit leans toward more blackberry notes and is very prevalent on the palate too. Combined with velvety tannins that lightly coat the mouth the finish ends with fresh red and black berries. This is classy drinking already but has some years ahead of it. Drink from 2018. Genesis Score 18.

**Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Lavaux Saint Jacques - SOLD OUT** 735.00

Very complex and deep, a dark and mysterious nose suggests the palate will be similar. The mouth feel is very sexy and complete with tight and velvety tannins. With lots of fruit there is much complexity with tones of minerality too. Very impressive and harmonious with a practically never-ending finish. Drink from 2019. Genesis Score 18.5+.

**Clos Vougeot Grand Cru - SOLD OUT** 1395.00

Very, very, very rich! Dense and earthy with a round and velvety feel. It unveils a basket of red berry fruit aromas - a luxurious wine that is so complete and round. Black, blue and red fruit flavours abound, framed with subtle minerality and nice acidity. The tannins are remarkably fine and yet so full. With time this will become even more chiseled and silky. Jancisrobinson.com Score: 16.5+.

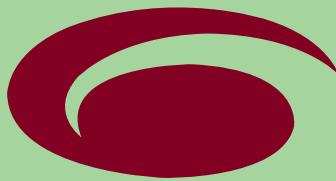
